CAREER OUTLOOK AND CERTIFICATION EXAMS

The Master of Science in Sports Medicine program trains students in master's level, evidence-based sports medicine by offering courses that cater to multiple career paths, and specific tracks that prepare students to sit for several external certification exams.

Graduates of this program will:

- Be prepared for careers in sports medicine consulting, sports medicine research, fitness instruction, and community exercise program development.
- As a medical professional (ND, MD, DO, DC, LAc, etc.), be able to develop a specialty in sports medicine for their practice.

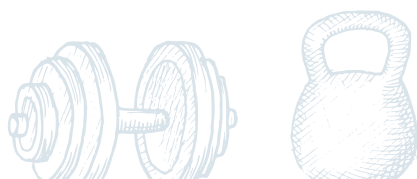
